1. Pre-Entry - \$12 Post Entry - \$15 (Pre-Entries are accepted by e-mail or phone to Tammy Kurtz 610-304-2875 or dtkurtz@msn.com) Pre-Entry Info needed: Rider's Name, Rider's Age, Mount's Name, Class #'s and Phone # / E-mail. PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE AUGUST 6th.
2. Full Payment or signed check must be left with the secretary before numbers will be issued.
3. Exhibitors mush scratch/add classes at the secretary's stand.
4. Appearance should be neat and workmanlike, SEI approved helmet is required to be worn at all times while mounted.
5. The Management reserves the rights to divide, combine, cancel or change the order of classes when necessary.
6. The decision of the judge will be final.
7. No Martingales permitted in under saddle classes.
8. Schooling permitted until 7:45am and schooling will be offered during the lunch break.
9. A current 2009 coggins must be presented with entries.
10. All dogs must be kept on a leash or left at home.
11. Food will be available on the grounds.
12. There will be 6 ribbons per class as well as a Champion and Reserve ribbons in each division.
13. Championship prizes will be awarded
